

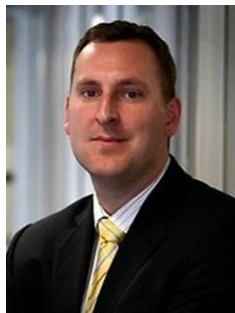
PRIVACY AWARENESS WEEK OFFICIAL LAUNCH
