## Making it easier for agencies to explain their collection of personal information

The Department of Justice and Attorney-General has released an online tool – On-Q – that makes generating a privacy statement easier for agencies if they collect Queenslanders' personal information.

What used to be a time consuming task for agencies is now just a few clicks away.

On-Q is user-friendly, provides step-by-step guidance to create a privacy statement, is free and is available to all Queensland government agencies.

It provides agencies with a draft privacy collection statement that helps explain to Queenslanders how personal information provided will be managed by that agency.


On-Q was inspired by the **New Zealand Privacy Commissioner's** open source Priv-o-matic privacy statement generator.
